

## **13th Manual: Particulars of recipients of concessions, permits or authorisation granted by the Public Authority**

Villagers of Karanpur, Bindraban and Nandbir Forests in Dasuya Forest Division have grazing rights which are open to grazing throughout the year except from 1st July to 30th September. The detailed concessions are furnished in the extract of Working Plan for Karanpur, Bindraban and Nandbir Forests.

Permits for felling of trees etc. under the provisions of Punjab Land Preservation Act, 1900 are issued to landowners in the areas closed under section 4 & 5 of the Act by DFOs in Kandi area. The list of such permits issued by each DFO is maintained in their respective offices and the same will be displayed on the notice board in the office of the concerned DFOs for information of the public.

Gaddies and Gujjars have grazing rights after paying a nominal fee (Tirni) as determined by the department in Kandi area of Gurdaspur Forest Division.

Bartandar and Khevatdar and right holders of Kandi area in Gurdaspur Forest Division also enjoy rights on forest produce as mentioned in the Forest Settlement Report and notifications issued by the State Govt. under Section 4 & 5 of the Land Preservation Act (PLPA) –1900.
