In exercise of Powers conferred by section 29 of Indian Forest Act, 1927 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Governor of Punjab is pleased to declare the lands acquired by the Punjab Government for raising Forest plantation in Tehsil Khadoor Sahib District Tarn-Taran, described in the schedule below to be protected forests and that the provisions of chapter-IV and section 68 of the said Act shall be applicable to them:-

Whereas by this notification certain forests and waste land mentioned in the schedule appended to the said notification have been declared to be protected under section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927. Now therefore the Governor of Punjab in exercise of the powers conferred by section 30 of the said act is pleased.

- (a) To declare all trees standing in or upon these lands to be reserved from the date of publication of this notification and
- (b) To prohibit from the same date the quarrying of stones or the burning of lime of charcoal or the collection or subjection to any manufacturing process or removal of any forest produce in any such forest and breaking up or clearing of land for cultivation, building and herding of cattle in any land in any such forests.

Whereas by this notification certain forests and waste land mentioned in the schedule annexed to the said notification have been declared to be protected forests under section 29 of the Indian Forests Act, 1927. Now therefore in exercise of the powers conferred by section 32 and 33 of the said Act, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to make the following rules applicable to all land comprised in the aforesaid notification:-

RULES

1. No person shall, cut fell or lop any tree for any purpose what so ever or remove any other forest produce without the previous permission of the Divisional Forest Officer, Amritsar Forest Division.
2. No person shall herd, pasture graze or retain any cattle on the said land.
3. No person shall cut or remove the grass, Kahi Kana without the previous approval of the Divisional Forest Officer, Amritsar Forest Division. The grass will be cut above ground level with sickle only.
4. No person shall clear or break up land for cultivation or for other purpose.
5. No person shall set fire to grass, trees, timber or kindle a fire on the land without taking reasonable precaution to prevent its spreading to any tree.
6. The income from compounding of offences against the rules under section 68 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 shall be credited to the Government.
